

The Santorini Wedding Planning Guide

How getting married in Santorini works

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| 1. Pick your date | Tell us your preferred ceremony dates. We check availability with the venues and the registrar and come back with real options and real prices. |
| 2. Choose the ceremony | Civil weddings are fully legal, performed by the registrar. Symbolic ceremonies carry the same feeling with no paperwork. Greek Orthodox and religious ceremonies are also possible. |
| 3. Order your documents | For a civil wedding your documents (passport copies, birth certificates, single-status letter) need apostille stamps and certified Greek translations. The single-status letter must be issued within 3 months of the wedding. |
| 4. Send us everything | We need your documents by email two months before the wedding. We handle the licence, the Town Hall and the registrar from here. |
| 5. Fly in and marry | You arrive a few days early, sign at the Town Hall, and we run the day itself - venue, flowers, photography, transport, all of it. |
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What it costs - current published prices

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| Civil wedding | EUR 950 - 3,870 across five tiers, from the Basic Civil Wedding to Diamond. |
| Symbolic ceremony | From EUR 1,550 - the promise without the paperwork. |
| Elopement for two | From EUR 2,250 with ceremony, photography and a candlelit dinner. |
| Micro wedding | EUR 1,550 - 4,560 for up to 10 guests. |
| Vow renewal | From EUR 1,550, above the caldera. |
| Yacht wedding | EUR 2,900 - private catamaran, celebrant, photographer, dinner on board. |
| All-inclusive | EUR 7,400 - 9,500 for 35-50 guests with venue, reception, meal, DJ and photography included. |
| Marriage proposal | EUR 450 - 2,100, from a photo-shoot proposal to a private yacht. |

Venues are priced separately unless a package says otherwise: Santorini still has free wedding venues, the Saint Nicholas chapel is EUR 450 per hour, and the caldera event venues quote by season.

The timeline that works

12+ months before	Choose and reserve your date - June and September sunset slots go first.
10-8 months	Decide the ceremony type and the venue.
8-6 months	Book the photographer, the menu and the details.
4-3 months	Order your legal documents (they expire after 3 months).
2 months	Send us the documents, apostilles included.
A few days before	Arrive on the island, sign, breathe, marry.

When to marry - and when the sun sets

May, June, September and early October are the sweet spot: warm, dry, and less crowded than high summer. Whatever the month, we advise a ceremony about an hour before sunset.

Sunset on the 15th, local time: May 20:17 · June 20:37 · July 20:37 · August 20:10 · September 19:27 · October 18:43
